Golf Manor Village Council Unanimous Resolution: Keep Early Voting Downtown

Move of early voting and registration operations will have negative impact on residents of older communities like Golf Manor.

Golf Manor, OH – January 29, 2014 – In its Monday, January 27, 2014 regular council meeting, the Golf Manor Village Council unanimously voted to direct Mayor Alan Zaffiro to send correspondence to Ohio Secretary of State Jon A. Husted and the Hamilton County Commissioners urging them to retain the Hamilton County Board of Elections early voting and registration operations in downtown Cincinnati.

During the last council election in November 2013, a significant number of Golf Manor residents utilized early voting by travelling to the Hamilton County Board of Elections offices by public transit.

In his letter, Mayor Zaffiro stated, “We understand the opportunity and need to consolidate, modernize and innovate election operations to be more efficient; however, the ability of voters to have easy access to early voting and other services provided by the Board of Elections must be a paramount consideration.”

Members of council include Vice-Mayor Brenda Dubose, and council members Sharon Chaney, Darlene Dangerfield, Donna Faulk, Ron Hirth and Ryan Tolle.

The Village of Golf Manor, Ohio is centrally located in Hamilton County, approximately 8 miles north of Downtown Cincinnati, incorporated in 1947.
